Welcome to Roundhouse Rising Festival, the Roundhouse's annual festival of new music. Taking place across 4 days, the festival will see live music from over 75 artists plus 3 days of special events dedicated to helping you break into the music industry.

Roundhouse Rising also provides performance opportunities and artistic development for young people who have progressed through the Roundhouse's creative programme. More than just a great venue, each year the Roundhouse works with over 3,000 11-25 year olds enabling them to realise their creative potential in live music, circus, spoken word, theatre and new media. Around 45 of the artists performing this weekend have come through this very programme, alongside Broadcast Volunteers, music producers, the DJ/MC collective and our Associate Artist scheme, all of whom will have a part to play in the festival.

Also, live music from Stage 1 will be livestreamed globally via Dailymotion. Filmed by our team of 18-25 year old trainee broadcasters from the Bloomberg Broadcast Volunteer Programme, this initiative takes the festival to a global audience. 
#### EYES ON THE WALL ACROSS THE BUILDING

#### **OUR PARTNERSHIP WITH** SOUTH AFRICA


