PROSECCO ZONIN BRUT, NV

£7 / £25

Italy

Deliberately light and refreshing in style, with a palate of fresh pear and dessert apple fruit, further lifted by subtle floral and almond aromas. Delicately off-dry, with a clean finish.

J DE TELMONT GRANDE RESERVE, NV

£45

Champagne

One of the few remaining family-owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

LAURENT-PERRIER BRUT, NV

£55

Champagne

Subtle citrus, toast and spice predominate this perfectly balanced Champagne, with a strong structure giving the wine good food.

ROSE

BOIS DE VIOLETTES, 2013

France

Bright and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The small proportion of Muscat adds a dash of juicy grapey notes.

DOMAINE LA CHAUTARDE, 2013

£6.90 / £8.80 / £25

South of France

A light, dry and fruity rosé, with strawberry, red cherry flavours accompanying more subtle flavours of watermelon and nectarine. Soft acidity and delicate juiciness make for a refreshed palate.

WHITE

Tavino Trebbiano, 2013

Italy

Pale in colour with aromas of citrus and melon which follow onto the palate with a lovely splash of zest and green apple

Bantry Bay Chenin Blanc, 2014

South Africa

An aromatic wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose and palate.

La Colline di San Giorgio Pinot Grigio, 2012

£5.80/£7.40/£21

Italy

A vibrant Pinot Grigio that offers much more character and class than some. Showing citrus fruit flavours and subtle floral aromas. Good acidity helps create a clean, refreshing wine.

Picpoul de Pinet Coteaux du Languedoc, Villemarin, 2012

South of France

Light and fresh, yet intensely aromatic. Flavours of peach, apricot and ripe pears cascade across the palate, finishing with a refreshing acidic lift and gentle mineral grip.

Luis Felipe Edwards Signature Series Viognier, 2013

Chile

Flavours of peach, apricot and ripe pears cascade across the palate, finishing with a refreshing acidic lift.

Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, 2013

New Zealand

Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.

Kuhlmann-Platz Gewurztraminer, Cave de Hunawehr, 2013

Alsace

An open, generous and straightforward wine, offering fresh pear and apricot fruit and a lifted smokiness. Gently off-dry, emphasising the soft, ripe fruit, the palate has a pleasing length.

Bourgogne Aligote, Chateau du Cray, 2013

£26

Burgundy

This dry wine expresses juicy and ripe citrus fruits enhanced by a real freshness and vivacity and hints of minerality.

Vega de la Reina Verdejo, Marques de la Concordia, Rueda, 2012

£27

Spain

Lively aromas of greenery and citrus fruits in the Sauvignon vein, accompanied by softer, melon and petal touches. Crisp and refreshing on the palate, with a lemony zing.

Montenovo Godello, Valdesil, Valdeorras, 2012

£30

Spain

Valdeorras is an appellation in an inland area of Galicia in northern Spain, which has become known for

its quality white wines from the little-known Godello grape, which does very well in the region's moderate maritime climate and rocky slate soils.

Soave Classico, Inama, 2012

£35

Italy

A youthful, green-tinged straw yellow wine, with a clean nose of grassy herbaceousness, and pear and pineapple fruit. Light in weight, yet with a palate-coating sense of texture.

Chablis 1er Cru 'Vaillons', Vocoret, 2012

£41

Burgundy

From lower yields and the best slopes in the region this wine is generous, revealing apricots, honey, flowers and almonds. Generous acidity and a rich texture enforce the elegant finish this wine has.

RED

MICHEL SERVIN ROUGE, 2012

£5/£6.30/£18

French regions

Supple and inviting, this wine blends the soft and jammy raspberry fruit of ripe Grenache with the firming influences of Carignan's blackberry flavours and robust tannin.

PRIMITIVO, VERGA, 2013

£5.40/£6.90/£19.50

Italy

An approachable, medium-bodied wine full of sunny red berry flavour and subtle hints of prune and violet on the nose. Smooth, drying tannins mingle with the rounded, juicy fruit.

PAVILLON TROIS ARCHES MERLOT, 2013

£6.10/£7.70/£22

South of France

Deep ruby red in colour with aromas of berries and sweet spice. The pallet is smooth and rich with a depth of flavour that continues in the mouth.

BARON DE BAUSSAC, CARIGAN, 2013

£6.60/£8.40/£24

South of France

Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length.

CAPILLA DE BARRO MALBEC, 2013

£6.90/£8.80/£25

Argentina

An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins.

SAN MILLAN RIOJA, CRIANZA, 2011

£26

Spain

Red cherry colour of medium intensity with violet hues. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. A very pleasant entry on the palate and a good finish.

WIRRA WIRRA "THE GOOD CATCH", 2013

£27

Australia

A brilliant crimson with a purple edge, this is a youthful and vibrant wine offering raspberry, cherry and blackberry fruit, lifted by hints of violet and spicy oak notes.

MORELLINO DI SCANSANO, POGGIOARGENTIERA, 2012/13

£28

Italy

Ripe cherry and strawberry fruit forms the backbone of this wine, which is medium-bodied and approachable, and fresh in feel. A subtly rustic streak gives a touch of complexity and food friendliness.

VIEUX REMPARTS, LUSSAC ST EMILION, 2012

£30

Bordeaux

This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flavour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate backed up by a smoky sandalwood character.

PASO CREEK CABERNET SAUVIGNON, PASO ROBLES, 2011

£35

California

Dark garnet red with cherry hues. The nose is multifaceted, offering glimpses of caramel, vanilla, black pepper and ripe black cherry. A dense yet supple palate with cocoa-like tannins.

VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO SUPERIORE RIPASSO, LA CASETTA, 2011

£41

Italy

A beautiful deep ruby hue and lots of almost confected cherry, plum and berry fruits complemented by vanilla hints. Fine and rounded, a velvety smooth palate bursting with intense and complex flavours.

DESSERT & FORTIFIED WINE

ROYAL TOKAJI LATE HARVEST, 2011

£8 / 125ml

Hungary

Pale green-gold colour. The nose is more delicate than many a Tokaji, with aromas of ripe peach, exotic fruit and blossom. Moderate palate weight, with a fine balance of intense sweetness and acidic lift.

TAYLOR'S LATE BOTTLED VINTAGE, 2007

£4 / 70ml

Port

Pale honeysuckle pink, and offering a clean nose of citrus fruit, offset by subtle floral and candied notes. Fresh acidity makes for an incisive and lively palate, with a rounded feel.
