What to expect when you visit the Roundhouse



Where is the performance?

- The show you are coming to see is being performed at the Roundhouse.
- This is what the Roundhouse looks like from the outside.



 If you are collecting your tickets, head to the box office where there might be a queue of people.



 Here you will be greeted by a member of staff who will ask you for your name and address so they can give you your rickets. They may also ask for I.D.




- If you already have your tickets, you can head straight down the corridor to the right of the stairs to the Sackler Space.
- You might be searched by security on the way.



- If you have any large items or a coat that you don't want to take into the performance with you, you can leave these in the cloakroom for a small fee.
- This is on the left of the stairs.



- Before entering the Sackler
 Space, a member of staff will check you tickets.
- There are accessible toilets to the right of these doors.



- Once inside the space, you can find somewhere to sit.
- Seating is usually unallocated in the Sackler Space but if you would like to reserve an accessible seat, please get in touch.



 The space will be dark and there might be flashing lights and loud noises during the performance.



- You can leave the performance at any time but may have to wait for a suitable break to re-enter again.
- If you want to find some quiet space, you can go to the Roundhouse Bar & Café, down the corridor and on your left.



Good to know...

- Our Bar & Café on the ground floor is open from 10.30am-11:30pm on performance days.
- Here you can buy drinks and snacks and there is plenty of seating.
